Community Agreement Variations

- Brainstorm community agreements using sticky notes, scrabble tiles, a team challenge, or other creative method.
- Cut up a quote or image, puzzle style, so that there is a piece for each member of the group. Have each group member write a positive quality on a piece of the quote. Challenge the group to solve the puzzle as each member shares the quality that they are committing to bringing to the team.
- Prepare your paper with the outline of a window, body, traffic signs or other shape(s) that lends itself to metaphor. (window of success, working as one, etc)
- Go 3D. Fold index cards "hamburger" style. Write a positive quality on the outside and a sentence inside. Attach the cards to create a sculpture.
- In pairs or groups of three, challenge participants to list as many positive group attributes on a card as they can in 90 seconds. Then share aloud. As each group is sharing their brainstorm, the other participants should cross off from their list any identical answers. Reporters should only share characteristics that have not been shared thus far.
- Sign with "Rock Star" signatures or create a bundle of sticks (stronger together)
- Write unwanted behaviors/qualities on slips of paper and "throw them away" in a trash can (real or symbolic).
- Surround a STOP sign with unwanted behaviors.
